RESOLUTION 18-05 Sponsored by Budget and Finance Committee

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of the County of Faulkner, State of Arkansas. An resolution to be entitled: A resolution to set aside and repay money expended from the Animal Control Fund.

WHEREAS, \$500,000 was recently expended from the Animal Control Fund, which is funded with voluntary tax payments of residents across Faulkner County who are mutually concerned about the safety and welfare of our animal population, and

WHEREAS, this money was used to purchase a building that was intended to be used as an animal shelter after approximately two years, once funds were available to operate it, and

WHEREAS, that building is presently being used by the Sheriff's Department, in exchange for rent payments back to the Animal Control Fund.

NOW THEREFORE:

Section 1:

The subject \$500,000 will be returned to the Animal Control Fund as soon as it is ready to be otherwise spent for animal control purposes, or, as soon as the county's sequestered funds are replenished.

Section 2:

Meanwhile, the animal control fund will continue to receive the rent payments, pro-rated up to the date of pay back of the funds.
