

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 20-____
Sponsored by Budget & Finance Committee

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of the County of Faulkner, State of Arkansas. An Ordinance to be entitled: An appropriation Ordinance to set the compensation of the Election Commissioners, to Declare an Emergency and for Other Purposes.

- Section 1: The Faulkner County Election Commissioners shall receive as compensation for their services, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per diem when a public meeting is held.
- Section 2: The Faulkner County Election Commissioners shall receive as compensation for their services, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day when a Commissioner shall, in the course of their duties as an Election Commissioner, spend four (4) or more hours in a calendar day dedicated to the performance of their duties in their official capacity as a Faulkner County Election Commissioner.
- Section 3: No Faulkner County Election Commissioner shall receive more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day for their services performed in their official capacity as a Faulkner County Election Commissioner.
- Section 4: This Ordinance, being necessary for the proper and timely conduct of County operations, shall incorporate this month's elections (March 2020) and shall include any and all forthcoming elections and future services from the Faulkner County Election Commissioners. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
- Section 5: All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, including, but not limited to, Faulkner County Ordinance 92-08.
- Section 6: If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance.
