

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 18-11
Sponsored by Budget and Finance Committee

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of the County of Faulkner, State of Arkansas. An Ordinance to be entitled: An Ordinance to Sequester Funds for construction and operation of an Animal Control Facility.

WHEREAS, the most economic and responsible use of public resources to solve the County's stray animal problem would be a City/County partnership, combining assets, and

WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of an Animal Control Shelter is \$2,500,000, and

WHEREAS, the County's Animal Control voluntary tax balance as of April 1, 2018 was \$1,387,000, and

NOW THEREFORE:

Section 1: Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000), offset by the income produced by the voluntary tax, is hereby annually sequestered for the construction cost of an animal control facility.

Section 2: After completion of construction of the above mentioned facility, Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000), offset by the income produced by the voluntary tax, will be sequestered annually for the Facility's annual operating cost.

Section 3: Upon obtaining approval from the City Council and Quorum Court, the City and County will work together pursuant to an Interlocal Agreement to develop the plans for an animal control shelter and operations plans for the shelter.
